

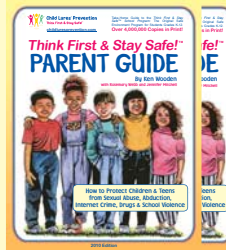
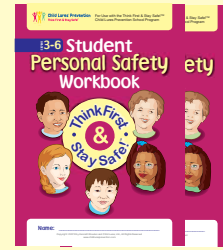

Common Questions:

What do students learn when they participate in the *Think First & Stay Safe™* School Program?

Students learn life skills to protect them from predatory crimes, offline and online. The program hones critical thinking skills and teaches students to recognize, trust and follow their instincts about people and situations. It reinforces the concept of personal boundaries and the importance of reporting abuse. Students learn how alcohol and other drugs can threaten personal safety, and the role and responsibility they can take in helping to keep their school safe and violence-free.

How was *Think First & Stay Safe™* developed?

Investigative reporter Ken Wooden interviewed hundreds of imprisoned sex offenders to uncover the various tactics they repeatedly used to secure victims. An author and former educator, Wooden classified their tactics into lure categories, researched and tested prevention strategies for each lure, and went on to develop the *Think First & Stay Safe™* school program.

Who teaches *Think First & Stay Safe™*?

In schools, the program is typically taught by a school counselor, nurse, resource officer or health, phys-ed, or classroom teacher. In parishes, the program is taught by DREs or caring parish volunteers.

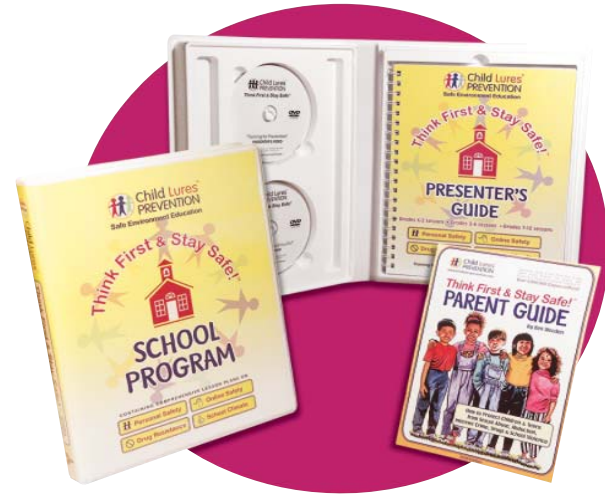
How long does it take to teach the program?

Think First & Stay Safe™ can conform to the time constraints of any classroom. DREs have embraced the ease of implementation, with scripted lesson plans designed to be taught in as little as 5-10 minutes each.

Many presenters opt to follow the suggested one or two week presentation timetables found in the Presenter's Guide; others teach it over the course of several weeks; still others create their own presentation schedule.

Has the program been proven to work?

Yes. *Think First & Stay Safe™* has been scientifically evaluated and, based on the federally mandated Principles of Effectiveness, shown to be highly effective in safeguarding youngsters. It is recommended the pre- and post-tests are administered to students participating in the program to allow each school or parish to gauge its effectiveness.



Is *Think First & Stay Safe™* age-appropriate?

Yes. The Presenter's Guide contains age-appropriate lesson plans for Grades K-2, 3-6 and 7-12. Presenters are encouraged to be sensitive to the maturity of their students, and to teach the program accordingly.

Does the program offer a balanced perspective?

Yes. Youngsters are repeatedly reassured that the vast majority of people are sincerely committed to the happiness and well-being of children and would not hurt or take advantage of them. Those who prey on children are the exception.

Does the program address online luring?

Yes. Most of the lures have both online and offline applications, and online safety is incorporated throughout the program. The Online Lure specifically and comprehensively addresses online luring as well.

Does the program address cyberbullying?

Yes. The program addresses harassment and bullying, both offline and online. It gives students effective steps to take to prevent and report these hurtful and unacceptable behaviors.

Is a Student Code of Conduct included?

Yes. A Student Code of Conduct is included, to be used at the school or parish's discretion. The program stresses the importance of treating all people with respect – and expecting the same in return.

Are juvenile perpetrators addressed?

Yes. As much as 40% of childhood sexual abuse is perpetrated by children, on children. The *Think First & Stay Safe™* program emphasizes that it is a crime for anyone – even a peer – to commit sexual abuse. The importance of reporting abuse and getting help from trusted adults is repeatedly stressed.

What does the program kit consist of?

Presenter's Video - "Training for Prevention":

Program creator Ken Wooden guides presenters through each lesson, sharing insights and highlights of his own presentations to students of various ages.

Presenter's Guide: Easy-to-follow scripted lesson plans for Grades K-2, 3-6, and 7-12, practice scenarios, follow-up activities, K-2 Handouts, pre/post tests, tools for parental involvement, and peer teaching opportunities.

Student Video - "Luring: What Would You Do?":

Four realistic dramatizations allow students to clearly visualize just how easily they may be lured into victimization. (Recommended for Grades 3 and up.)

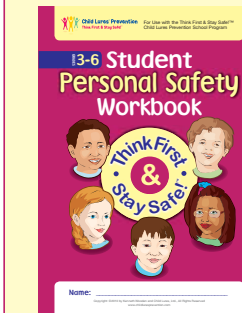

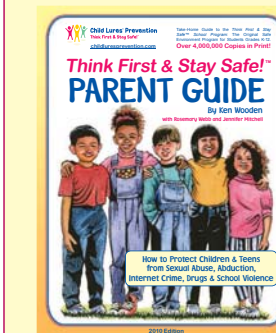
